BERROCO MERCADO (100 grs):
5 (6, 7, 7, 8, 9, 9) hanks #4128 Cielo

NEEDLES and NOTIONS

Knitting needles, sizes 8 (5.00 mm)
and 10 (6.00 mm) *or size to obtain
gauge*

2 stitch holders

1 stitch marker

Four 1¼" buttons

GAUGE

15 sts and 18 rows = 4" in St st on
larger needles

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BACK

With smaller needles, cast on 65 (73, 79, 87, 95, 103, 109) sts.

Set Up Rib: Row 1 (RS): K1, * p1, k1; rep from * across.

Row 2: P1, * k1, p1; rep from * across. Rep these 2 rows until piece measures 1½" from beginning, end on RS.

Change to larger needles and work even in St st until piece measures 4 (4, 4½, 4½, 5, 5, 5)" from beginning, end on WS.

Dec Row (RS): K2, k2 tog, knit to last 4 sts, SSK, k2—2 sts dec'd. Work even for 6½" then rep Dec Row once more—61 (69, 75, 83, 91, 99, 105) sts. Work even until piece measures 12½ (12½, 13, 13, 13½, 13½, 13½)" from beginning, end on WS.

Inc Row (RS): K2, M1R, k to last 2 sts, M1L, k2—2 sts inc'd. Work even for 3" then rep Inc Row once more—65 (73, 79, 87, 95, 103, 109) sts. Work even until piece measures 16½ (16½, 17, 17, 17½, 17½, 17½)" from beginning, end on WS.

Shape Armholes: Bind off 4 (5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10) sts at beginning of the next 2 rows, then 2 sts at beginning of the next 2 rows—53 (59, 63, 69, 75, 81, 85) sts.

Dec Row (RS): K2, k2tog, knit to the last 4 sts, SSK, k2—2 sts dec'd. Rep Dec Row every RS row 3 (4, 4, 5, 6, 8, 8) times more—45 (49, 53, 57, 61, 63, 67) sts. Work even until armholes measure 6 (6, 6½, 7, 7, 7½, 8)", end on WS. Change to smaller needles and work in ribbing as for lower edge for 1½", end on WS.

Shape Shoulders: Bind off 6 (7, 8, 9, 10, 10, 11) sts at beginning of the next 2 rows, then 5 (6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11) sts at beginning of the next 2 rows. Bind off remaining 23 sts for back neck edge.

POCKET LININGS (Make 2)

With larger needles, cast on 22 sts. Work even in St st for 5½", end on WS. Slip stitches to a holder.

LEFT FRONT

With smaller needles, cast on 37 (41, 45, 49, 53, 55, 59) sts.

Establish Front Band: Row 1 (RS): K1, * p1, k1; rep from *



to last 8 sts, pm, k8.

Row 2: Slip 2 wyif, k6, sm, p1, * k1, p1; rep from * across. Work even in pattern as established until piece measures 1½" from beginning, end on RS. Change to larger needles. Keeping 8 sts at front edge in pattern as established and remaining stitches in St st, work even until piece measures 4 (4, 4½, 4½, 5, 5, 5)" from beginning, end on WS.

Dec Row (RS): K2, k2tog, work to end—36 (40, 44, 48, 52, 54, 58) sts. Work even until piece measures 9½ (9½, 10, 10, 10½, 10½, 10½)" from beginning, end on WS.

Insert Pocket Lining: Next Row (RS): K3 (5, 7, 9, 11, 12, 14), k22 sts of pocket lining from holder, slip the next 22 sts from LH needle to holder, work to end—36 (40, 44, 48, 52, 54, 58) sts. Work even until piece measures 10½ (10½, 11, 11, 11½, 11½, 11½)", end on WS. Rep Dec Row once more—35 (39, 43, 47, 51, 53, 57) sts. Work even until piece measures 12½ (12½, 13, 13, 13½, 13½, 13½)" from beginning, end on WS.

Inc Row (RS): K2, M1R, work to end—36 (40, 44, 48, 52, 54, 58) sts. Work even until piece measures 14 (14, 14½, 14½, 15, 15, 15)" from beginning, end on WS.

Shape Neck: Neck Dec Row (RS): Knit to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, sm, work to end—1 st dec'd at neck. Rep Neck Dec Row every 8th row 0 (0, 0, 0, 0, 2, 0) times more, every 6th row 3 (3, 2, 3, 3, 4, 7) times, then every 4th row 4 (4, 6, 5, 5, 0, 0) times. AT THE SAME TIME, when piece measures 15½ (15½, 16, 16, 16½, 16½, 16½)" from beginning, end on WS. Work Inc Row once more. When piece measures 16½ (16½, 17, 17, 17½, 17½, 17½)" from beginning, end on WS.

Shape Armhole: Continue to work neck decs and AT THE SAME TIME, bind off 4 (5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10) sts at armhole edge once, then bind off 2 sts at armhole edge once, end on WS.

Armhole Dec Row (RS): K2, k2tog, work to end, continuing to dec at neck as before—1 st dec'd at armhole. Rep Armhole Dec Row every RS row 3 (4, 4, 5, 6, 8, 8) times more. When all armhole and neck decs have been completed, work even on 19 (21, 23, 25, 27, 28, 30) sts until armhole measures 6 (6, 6½, 7, 7, 7½, 7½)", end on WS, inc 0 (0, 0, 0, 0, 1, 1) st at end of the last row—19 (21, 23, 25, 27, 29, 31) sts. Keeping 8 sts at front edge in pattern as established, work remaining sts in ribbing as for back until armhole measures 7½ (7½, 8, 8½, 8½, 9, 9½)", end on WS, dec 0 (0, 0, 0, 0, 1, 1) st at end of last row—19 (21, 23, 25, 27, 28, 30) sts.

Shape Shoulder: Bind off 6 (7, 8, 9, 10, 10, 11) sts at armhole edge once, then 5 (6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11) sts once, removing marker—8 sts. Work even in pattern as established for neck extension for 7", end on WS. Bind off.

Mark placement of 4 buttons on frontband, the first 2½" up from lower edge, the last ½" below beginning of neck shaping and the other 2 evenly spaced between.

RIGHT FRONT

With smaller needles, cast on 37 (41, 45, 49, 53, 55, 59) sts.

Establish Front Band: Row 1 (RS): Slip 1 wyib, k7, pm, K1, * p1, k1; rep from * across.

Row 2: P1, * k1, p1; rep from * to marker, sm, k8. Work even in pattern as established until piece measures 1½" from beginning, end on RS. Change to larger needles. Keeping 8 sts at front edge in pattern as established and remaining stitches in St st, work even until piece measures 2½" from beginning, end on WS.

Buttonhole Row (RS): K3, bind off 2 sts, work to end.

Following Row: Work in pattern as established, cast on 2 sts over sts bound off on previous row. As you work, make 3 more buttonholes opposite markers on left frontband. Work even in pattern as established until piece measures 4 (4, 4½, 4½, 5, 5, 5)" from beginning, end on WS.

Dec Row (RS): Work to the last 4 sts, SSK, k2—36 (40, 44, 48, 52, 54, 58) sts. Work even until piece measures 9½ (9½, 10, 10, 10½, 10½, 10½)" from beginning, end on WS.

Insert Pocket Lining: Next Row (RS): K8, sm, k3 (5, 7, 9, 11, 12, 14), k22 sts of pocket lining from holder, slip the next 22 sts from LH needle to holder, work to end—36 (40, 44, 48, 52, 54, 58) sts. Work even until piece measures 10½ (10½, 11, 11, 11½, 11½, 11½)", end on WS. Rep Dec Row once more—35 (39, 43, 47, 51, 53, 57) sts. Work even until piece measures 12½ (12½, 13, 13, 13½, 13½, 13½)" from beginning, end on WS.

Inc Row (RS): Work to the last 2 sts, M1L, k2—36 (40, 44, 48, 52, 54, 58) sts. Work even until piece measures 14 (14, 14½, 14½, 15, 15, 15)" from beginning, end on WS.

Shape Neck: Neck Dec Row (RS): Knit to marker, sm, SSK, work to end—1 st dec'd at neck. Rep Neck Dec Row every 8th row 0 (0, 0, 0, 0, 2, 0) times more, every 6th row 3 (3, 2, 3, 3, 4, 7) times, then every 4th row 4 (4, 6, 5, 5, 0, 0) times. AT THE SAME TIME, when piece measures 15½ (15½, 16, 16, 16½, 16½, 16½)" from beginning, end on WS. Work Inc Row once more. When piece measures 16½ (16½, 17, 17, 17½, 17½, 17½)" from beginning, end on RS.

Shape Armhole: Continue to work neck decs and AT THE SAME TIME, bind off 4 (5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10) sts at armhole edge once, then bind off 2 sts at armhole edge once, end on WS.

Armhole Dec Row (RS): Work to the last 4 sts, SSK, k2—1 st dec'd at armhole. Still continuing to dec at neck edge as before, rep Armhole Dec Row every RS row 3 (4, 4, 5, 6, 8, 8) times more. When all armhole and neck decs have been completed, work even on 19 (21, 23, 25, 27, 29, 31) sts

until armhole measures 6 (6, 6½, 7, 7, 7½, 7½)", end on RS, inc 0 (0, 0, 0, 0, 1, 1) st at end of the last row—19 (21, 23, 25, 27, 29, 31) sts. Keeping 8 sts at front edge in pattern as established, work remaining sts in ribbing as for back until armhole measures 7½ (7½, 8, 8½, 8½, 9, 9½)", end on RS, dec 0 (0, 0, 0, 0, 1, 1) st at end of last row—19 (21, 23, 25, 27, 28, 30) sts.

Shape Shoulder: Bind off 6 (7, 8, 9, 10, 10, 11) sts at armhole edge once, then 5 (6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11) sts once, removing marker—8 sts. Work even in pattern as established for neck extension for 7", end on WS. Bind off.

SLEEVES

With larger needles, cast on 37 sts. Work even in Garter St for 1". Work even in St st until sleeve measures 2" from beginning, end on WS.

Inc Row (RS): K1, M1R, knit to last st, M1L, k1—2 sts inc'd. Rep Inc Row every 22nd (12th, 8th, 6th, 6th, 4th, 4th) row 2 (1, 1, 2, 10, 2, 8) time(s), then every 24th (14th, 10th, 8th, 8th, 6th, 6th) row 1 (4, 6, 7, 1, 10, 6) time(s) more—45 (49, 53, 57, 61, 63, 67) sts. Work even until sleeve measures 18" from beginning, end on WS.


Shape Cap: Bind off 4 (5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10) sts at beginning of the next 2 rows, then 2 sts at beginning of the next 2 rows, end on WS—33 (35, 37, 39, 41, 41, 43) sts.

Dec Row (RS): K1, k2tog, knit to the last 3 sts, SSK, k1—2 sts dec'd. Rep Dec Row every 4th row 6 (5, 5, 5, 4, 5, 5) times, then every RS row 0 (2, 3, 4, 6, 5, 6) times, end on WS—19 sts. Bind off 2 sts at beg of the next 2 rows—15 sts. Work even on these stitches for saddle for 3 (3½, 4, 4½, 5, 5½, 6)", end on WS. Bind off.

FINISHING

Pocket Bands: With RS facing, slip 22 sts from left front holder to larger needles. Join yarn and knit 6 rows. Bind off. Repeat on right front. Sew side edges of pocket bands to RS of fronts. Sew pocket linings to WS of fronts. Sew front and back shoulders to side edges of saddles at top of sleeves. Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew bound-off edges of neck extensions together. Sew inner edges of neck extensions to tops of saddles and back neck edge with seam at center. Sew on buttons. Weave in all ends and block as desired.





STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginning

CC: contrasting color

CDD: Centered Double Decrease—Slip 2 together (as if to k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over

cn: cable needle

dec: decrease

dpn(s): double pointed needle(s)

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side row.

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side row

Garter St: Knit EVERY row when working back and forth in rows. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working in the round.

inc: increase

k: knit

k tbl: knit through the back loop(s)

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

k3tog: knit 3 stitches together

kfb: knit in the front and back of the next st

LH: left hand

LLI: Left Lifted Increase—Insert LH needle into the purl bump one row below the st just worked on the RH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)

M1: Make 1—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1L: Make 1 Left—Work as for M1.

M1p: Make 1 purl—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1pL: Make 1 purl Left—Work as for M1p.

M1pR: Make 1 purl Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Make 1 Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

MC: main color

p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)

p2tog: purl 2 stitches together

p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

pat(s): pattern(s)

pm: place marker

pssso: pass slipped stitch over knit stitch

rep: repeat

Rev St st: Reverse Stockinette Stitch—Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round.

RH: right hand

RLI: Right Lifted Increase—Insert RH needle into the purl bump of the next st on the LH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)

rnd(s): round(s)

RS: right side

sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

SSSK: Slip 3 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 3 stitches and knit 3 together.

st(s): stitch(es)

St st: Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.

tbl: through back loop(s)

w&t: wrap and turn, a method of concealing a hole created in short row shaping. On RS rows: With yarn held in front, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the back. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. On WS Rows: With yarn held in back, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the front. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. Unless otherwise indicated, each time you come to a wrapped stitch when working subsequent rows, slip the wrap back over stitch and onto needle, then work the wrap together with its accompanying stitch.

WS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in back

wyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

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
