## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 16½" wide x 17" high (not including handles)

## YARN

**BERROCO PIMA 100** (100 grs):  
2 hanks each #8429 Zinnea (C1)  
and #8426 Cosmos (C2)

## HOOKS and NOTIONS

Crochet hook size 4.00 mm (F) or  
size to obtain gauge  
1 pair of round tubular handles,  
8" diameter

## GAUGE

20 sc and 22 rows = 4"

*To save time and ensure accurate  
measurements, take time to check  
gauge.*

## BAG

### Side 1

With C1, ch 92.

Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch to end. Ch 1, turn.

Work 7 more rows of sc. Ch 1, turn.

**Pattern Stitch: Row 1 (Set-Up Row- RS):** With C1, work 8 sc, change to C2, ch 3, \* skip 4 sc, 3 sc in next sc, ch 3; rep from \* to last 8 sc, change to C1, work 8 sc, ch 1, turn.

**Row 2 (WS):** With C1, work 8 sc, change to C2, ch 3, \* sc in each of 3 sc, ch 3; rep from \* to last 8 sc, change to C1, work 8 sc, ch 1, turn.

**Row 3 (RS):** With C1 work 8 sc, change to C2, ch 3, \* 3 sc in center sc of sc group, ch 3; rep from \* to last 8 sc, change to C1, work 8 sc, ch 1, turn.

Rep Rows 2 & 3 for Pattern Stitch until piece measures 13" from beginning, end on WS with Row 2.

**Shape Top:** Continue with Row 3, work over 5 sc groups, ch 3, 1 sc in center of next sc group, ch 1, turn.

**Right-Hand Side:** Sc in sc, work in pattern to end, ch 1, turn.

Continue in this manner over 1 less group twice more.

Break off C2. With C1 only, sc in each sc and 3 sc in each ch-3 space, sc in last sc, ch 1, turn.

Work 7 more rows of sc.

**Next Row:** Work 1 sl st in each sc across. Break yarn.

**Shape Left-Hand Side:** With RS facing, skip center 2 sc groups, join C2 in center of next sc group, work 1 sc, ch 3, continue in pattern to end. Complete as for Right-Hand Side.

### Side 2

With RS facing, working in the bottom of the chain foundation, join C1 and work 1 sc in each chain (90). Complete as for side 1.

## FINISHING

Sew sides of bag. Block as desired before attaching to handles.

Work in sc around each lower half of each handle, working around handle and through curved opening at each side of top of bag.



## STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

**beg:** beginning

**CC:** contrasting color

**cont:** continue

**ch:** chain

**dec:** decrease

**dc:** double crochet

**dtr:** double treble crochet

**est:** established

**hdc:** half double crochet

**inc:** increase

**MC:** main color

**pat(s):** pattern(s)

**pm:** place marker

**rep:** repeat

**rnd(s):** round(s)

**RS:** right side

**sc:** single crochet

**sl st:** slip stitch

**sliding loop:** Form a loop of yarn around your fingers, with the end attached to the ball on the right and the tail on the left. Insert hook into the loop under both pieces of yarn and draw up a loop onto hook. (This does not count as your first stitch.) Work first row into the original loop. Pull up the yarn tail after your first row is complete to close the loop.

**sp:** space

**st(s):** stitch(es)

**tog:** together

**tr:** treble

**WS:** wrong side

**yo:** yarn over

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
