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DONNER

Designed by Donna Yacino Skill level: Intermediate One size

finished measurements

Chest (closed) – 6" Length – 3¾"

yarn

BERROCO REMIX (100 grs): 1 ball #3991 Juniper (MC) BERROCO MYKONOS (50 grs): small amount #8511 Aphrodite (CC1)

needles and notions

Straight needles, size 7 (4.50 mm) or size to obtain gauge

1 set (4) double pointed needles (dpns), size 7 (4.50 mm)

Tapestry needle Waste yarn to hold sts

gauge

24 sts and 28 rows = 4" in Reverse St st with MC To save time, take time to check gauge

NOTE

This garment is worked in one piece from the neck down.

STITCH GLOSSARY

Kfb: Knit in front and back of next st – 1 st inc'd

BODY

Yoke: With straight needles, using MC, cast on 20 sts. [Purl 1 row, knit 1 row] twice. Purl 1 row.

Inc Row 1 (WS): K2, * M1, k2, rep from * across – 29 sts. Work even in Reverse St st for 1", end with a RS row.

Inc Row 2 (WS): K2, M1, [k3, M1] 4 times, k1, [M1, k3] 4 times, M1, k2 – 37 sts. Purl 1 row.

Divide for Sleeves: Next Row (WS): K8, sl 4 sts to waste yarn for sleeve, cast on 2 sts, k13, sl 4 sts to waste yarn for sleeve, cast on 2 sts, k8 – 33 sts. Work even in Reverse St st until piece measures 3" from beg, end on RS.

Inc Row 3 (WS): * K2, kfb, rep from * to last 3 sts, end k3 – 43 sts. Work even in Reverse St st until piece measures 3½" from beg, end on RS. Bind off purlwise on WS.

SLEEVES

SI 4 sts from waste yarn to dpn, join MC then pick up and knit 4 sts over 2 cast-on sts – 8 sts. Divide sts on 3 needles, place marker and join for working in the round. Work even in Reverse St st (purl every rnd) for 1". Bind off purlwise.

FINISHING

Thread tapestry needle with 1 strand of CC1 and work French knots across yoke and tops of sleeves as in photo, wrapping yarn once around needle. Weave in all ends. Lap right front over left front and tack in place.



RUDOLF

Designed by Amy Palmer Skill level: Intermediate One size

finished measurements

Chest – 7" Length – 3"

yarn

BERROCO COMFORT DK (50 grs): 1 ball #2702 Pearl (MC), small amount #2745 Filbert (CC1) and one 10" long strand of #2751 True Red (CC2)

needles and notions

Straight needles, size 4 (3.50 mm) or size to obtain gauge

Tapestry needle

gauge

24 sts and 31 rows = 4" in St st To save time, take time to check gauge

NOTE

This garment is worked all in one piece, starting at lower front edge and ending at lower back edge with sts cast on then bound off for sleeves. When working chart, as you change colors, make sure to pick up new color from underneath old color, wrapping yarn so there are no holes.

SWEATER

Front: With MC, cast on 21 sts.

Set-Up Rib: Row 1 (WS): P1, * k1, p1, rep from * across.

Row 2 (RS): K1, * p1, k1, rep from * across. Rep Row 1 once more.

Next Row (RS): Join CC1 and begin working from chart. Work even until Row 16 of chart has been completed.

Begin Sleeves: Next Row (RS): With MC, using cable cast-on method, cast on 14 sts, k14 then work

Row 17 of chart to end - 35 sts.

Next Row (WS): With MC, using cable cast-on method, cast on 14 sts, p14, work Row 18 of chart over 21 sts, purl to end – 49 sts. Fasten off CC1 and work from here with MC. Work even in St st for 4 rows, end with a WS row.

Shape Neck: Next Row (RS): K22, bind off 5 sts, knit to end.

Next Row (WS): P22, using cable cast-on method, cast on 5 sts, purl to end – 49 sts. Work even in St st for 4 rows, end with a WS row.


End Sleeves: Bind off 14 sts at beg of the next 2 rows – 21 sts. Work even in St st for 16 rows, end with a WS row.


Set-Up Rib: Row 1 (RS): K1, * p1, k1, rep from * across.

Row 2 (WS): P1, * k1, p1, rep from * across. Rep Row 1 once more. Bind off in ribbing.

FINISHING

Cut a 10" long strand of CC2 and thread into tapestry needle. Embroider 1 duplicate st over st indicated on chart. Sew side and sleeve seams. Weave in all ends.







MOONRACER

Designed by Amy Christoffers Skill level: Intermediate One size

finished measurements

Chest – $5\frac{1}{2}$ " Length – $3\frac{3}{4}$ "

yarn

BERROCO BRIO (100 grs): 1 ball #9490 Foxtrot

needles and notions

1 set (5) double pointed knitting needles (dpns), size 10 (6.00 mm) or size to obtain gauge

gauge

12 sts and 19 rnds = 4" in St st To save time, take time to check gauge

SWEATER

Cast on 12 sts. Divide sts evenly onto 3 dpns, place marker and join for working in the round.

Collar: Rnd 1: * K1, p1, rep from * around. Rep this rnd twice more.

Yoke: Knit 1 rnd.

Inc Rnd 1: K1, M1, k5, M1, k1, M1, k5, M1 – 4 sts

inc'd. Knit 1 rnd.

Inc Rnd 2: K1, M1, k7, M1, k1, M1, k7, M1 – 4 sts

inc'd. Knit 1 rnd.

Inc Rnd 3: K1, M1, k9, M1, k1, M1, k9, M1 – 24 sts

on needle. Knit 1 rnd.

Divide for Sleeves: First Sleeve: SI the last 2 sts worked from the end of the previous rnd onto a new dpn, k3 from beginning of the rnd onto same needle – 5 sts for sleeve. Mark the next st.

I-Cord: * Row 1 (RS): SI 5 sts to beg of needle to work the next row from RS, K5. Rep from * 4 times more. Bind off.

Rejoin yarn to the marked st and knit 7 sts.

Second Sleeve: Knit 5 sts onto a new dpn. Mark the next st. Complete as for First Sleeve.

Rejoin yarn to the marked st and work to the end of rnd. Redistribute remaining 14 sts onto 3 dpns and knit 8 rnds. Bind off knitwise.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends.



HERBIE

Designed by Alison Green Skill level: Intermediate One size

finished measurements

Chest -5" Length $-3\frac{1}{2}$ "

yarn

BERROCO COMFORT DK (50 grs): 1 ball #2702 Pearl (MC) and small amount each #2751 True Red (CC1) and #2777 Holly (CC2)

needles and notions

Crochet hook, size 3.75 mm (F) or size to obtain gauge

Safety pin for marker

gauge

22 sc and 4 rnds = 4" in sc To save time, take time to check gauge

STITCH GLOSSARY

Sc2tog: Single Crochet 2 sts tog

Insert hook in first st. Yo, draw up a loop (2 loops on hook). Insert hook in next st, yo, draw up a loop (3 loops on hook). Yo, draw yarn through all 3 loops on hook.

BODY

With CC1, ch 26. Join with a sl st in first ch.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in same st, sc in each ch around, with CC2, join with a sl st in beg ch-1 – 25 sc. Leave CC1 attached.

Rnd 2: With CC2, ch 1, sc in same st, sc in each sc around, with CC1, join with a sl st in beg ch-1. Cut CC2.

Rnd 3: With CC1, ch 1, sc in same st, sc in each sc around, w2ith MC, join with a sl st in beg ch-1. Cut CC1.

Rnd 4: With MC, ch 1, sc in same st, sc in each sc around, join with a sl st in beg ch-1. Rep Rnd 4 nine times more. Fasten off. Cut yarn and set body aside.

SLEEVES (Make 2)

With CC1, ch 8, join with a sl st in first ch. Work all rnds as for body. At the end of last rnd on second sleeve, leave MC attached.

YOKE

Joining Rnd: With MC (still attached from second sleeve), ch 1, sc into first sc on body, then into next 12 sc on body; sc in all 8 sc at top of first (unattached) sleeve; sc across remaining 13 sc of body; sc in all 8 sc at top of second sleeve, join with a sl st in first sc – 42 sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in same st, sc2tog, * sc, sc2tog, rep from * around, join with a sl st in beg ch-1 – 28 sc.

Rnds 3 and 4: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join with a sl st in beg ch-1.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in same sc, sc, sc2tog, * 2 sc, sc2tog, rep from * around, with CC1, join with a sl st in beg ch-1 – 21 sc. Cut MC.

Rnd 6: With CC1, ch 1, sc in same st, 4 sc, sc2tog, * 5 sc, sc2tog, rep from * around – 18 sc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends.

ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

Knit

beg: beginning **CC:** contrasting color

cdd (centered double decrease): Slip 2 together,

knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over.

cn: cable needlecont: continuedec: decrease

dpn: double pointed needles

est: establishedinc: increaseK: knit

k tbl: knit through the back loop(s)k2tog: Knit 2 stitches togetherk3tog: Knit 3 stitches together

LH: left hand **MC:** main color

M1: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1L: Work as for M1.

M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1pL: Work as for M1p.

M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)

pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker

psso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch **p2tog:** purl 2 stitches together

p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch

p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

rem: remaining rep: repeat RH: right hand rnd(s): round(s) RS: right side sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

SSP: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.

st(s): stitch(es)

TBL: through back loop(s)

tog: togetherWS: wrong side

wyib: with yarn in backwyif: with yarn in front

yo: yarn over

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side

row

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side

row

STOCKINETTE ST (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

dc: double crochet **hdc:** half double crochet

sc: single crochet
sl st: slip stitch
sp: space
tr: treble
