One size

finished measurements

Approximately 8" around (foot and leg) x 7" long (from top of sock to start of heel)

materials

BERROCO COMFORT SOCK

(100 grs): 1 ball #1702 Pearl
Three 16" circular needles, size 3 (3.25 mm) *or size to obtain gauge*
2 st markers
Tapestry needle
Scrap yarn in a different color for provisional cast-on

gauge

30 sts and 40 rnds = 4" in St st and Lace Pat

To save time, take time to check gauge

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NOTE: We recommend using yarns called for in our instructions. Every effort has been made to ensure that directions contained in this book are accurate and complete, however errors do occur. All pattern PDFs are updated when corrections are made. In the event of finding an error, please make sure you've downloaded the most recent version.

NOTE

These socks are worked on 2 circular needles. When changing from one needle to the other, make sure that you pick up the opposite end of the needle holding the sts you will be working. If you pick up the end of the other needle, you will wind up with all the sts on one needle and will have to divide them onto 2 needles again. It is sometimes helpful to use 2 different colored needles or to mark both ends of one needle with nail polish or a permanent marker.

LACE PATTERN 1

(Multiple of 12 sts)

Rnd 1: Knit.

Rnd 2: * K1, yo, SSK, k1, k2tog, yo, rep from * around.

Rnd 3: Knit.

Rnd 4: * K1, yo, k1, sl 1, k2tog, pssso, rep from * around.

Rnd 5: Knit.

Rnd 6: Rep Rnd 2.

Rnd 7: Knit.

Rnd 8: * K1, k2tog, (yo, k1) twice, sl 1, k2tog, pssso, (k1, yo) twice, SSK, rep from * around.

Rep these 8 rnds for Lace Pat 1

LACE PATTERN 2

(Multiple of 6 sts)

Rnds 1 – 7: Rep Rnds 1 – 7 of Lace Pat 1.

Rnd 8: * K2tog, (k1, yo) twice, SSK, rep from * 4 times more.

Rep these 8 rnds for Lace Pat 2.

SOCK (Make 2)

Cast on 60 sts, using provisional cast-on. Divide sts onto 2 circular needles, pm and join for working in the rnd. Knit 7 rnds.

Eyelet Rnd: * Yo, k2tog, rep from * around. Knit 8 rnds. Sl sts from provisional cast-on to third circular



needle. Fold piece in half at Eyelet Rnd with WS together so that third circular needle is behind the 2 circular needles in use.

Joining Rnd: Insert point of RH needle through first st on circular needle in use and first st on third circular needle and knit them tog. Continue in this manner until all sts on third circular needle have been used – 60 sts. Drop third needle and continue working with the 2 original circular needles. Work in k1, p1 ribbing for 6 rnds, then work even in Lace Pat 1 until 8 repeats of Lace Pat (64 rnds) have been worked, end on Rnd 8.

Shape Heel Flap: Row 1 (RS): Sl 1, k29, turn.

Leave remaining 30 sts on second circular needle unworked. Drop marker.

Note: For heel flap, you will be working back and forth in St st on only the first 30 sts.

Row 2 (WS): Sl 1, p29. Rep the last 2 rows 12 times more, end on WS.

Turn Heel: Short Rows: Row 1 (RS): Sl 1, k16, k2tog, k1, turn – 29 sts.

Row 2 (WS): Sl 1, p5, p2tog, p1, turn – 28 sts.

Row 3: Sl 1, k6, k2tog, k1, turn – 27 sts.

Row 4: Sl 1, p7, p2tog, p1, turn – 26 sts.

Row 5: Sl 1, k8, k2tog, k1, turn – 25 sts.

Row 6: Sl 1, p9, p2tog, p1, turn – 24 sts.

Row 7: Sl 1, k10, k2tog, k1, turn – 23 sts.

Row 8: Sl 1, p11, p2tog, p1, turn – 22 sts.

Row 9: Sl 1, k12, k2tog, k1, turn – 21 sts.

Row 10: Sl 1, p13, p2tog, p1, turn – 20 sts.

Row 11: Sl 1, k14, k2tog, k1, turn – 19 sts.

Row 12: Sl 1, p15, p2tog, p1, turn – 18 sts.

Heel Gusset: Next Row (RS): Knit across 18 sts of heel flap, pick up and knit 15 sts along left edge of heel flap, with second needle, work across 30 unworked sts in Lace Pat 2. Mark for beg of rnd and carry marker up. Then with first needle, pick up and knit 15 sts along right edge of heel flap – 78 sts (48 sts on back needle in St st and 30 sts on front needle in Lace Pat 2). **Note:** From here you will again be working in the round on 2 needles. Knit to end of first (back) needle, then work in Lace Pat 2 across second (front) needle to beg of rnd.

Dec Rnd: With back needle, k1, SSK, knit to last 3 sts on needle, k2tog, k1; with front needle, work across in Lace Pat 2 – 2 sts dec'd on back needle. Work 1 rnd even. Rep these 2 rnds 8 times more – 60 sts (30 sts on each needle). Keeping 30 sts on back needle in St st and 30 sts on front needle in Lace Pat 2, work even until sock measures 1½" less than desired length (the 2 circular needles will allow you to try on the sock to check the length). Discontinue Lace Pat 2 at this point and work all sts in St st.

Shape Toe: Dec Rnd: With back needle, k1, SSK, knit to 3 sts before end of needle, k2tog, k1; with front needle, k1, SSK, knit to 3 sts before end of needle, k2tog, k1 – 2 sts dec'd on each needle. Knit 1 rnd. Rep these 2 rnds 8 times more – 12 sts on each needle. Break off yarn leaving an 18" long end. Thread end into tapestry needle. Hold needles parallel with each other and weave toe sts tog using Kitchener St.



ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

dec: decrease

k: knit

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

p: purl

p2tog: purl 2 stitches together

pat(s): pattern(s)

pm: place marker

pssso: pass slipped stitch over knit stitch

rep: repeat

RH: right hand

rnd(s): round(s)

RS: right side

sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

st(s): stitch(es)

Stockinette stitch (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round. **tog:** together

WS: wrong side

yo: yarn over

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
