2 stitch holders
GAUGE
10 sts and 14 rows $=4$ " $/ 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ in Pattern Stitch on larger needles To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

## PATTERN STITCH (Odd number of sts)

Row 1 (WS): P1, * k1, p1, rep from * across.
Row 2 (RS): Knit.
Rep these 2 rows for Pattern Stitch.

## BACK

With larger needles, cast on $(51,57,61)[67,71,77]\{81,87,93\}$ sts. Work even in Pattern Stitch for 8" / 20 cm , end on WS.

Dec Row (RS): K1, k2tog, work to last 3 sts, SSK, k1-2 sts dec'd.
Rep Dec Row every 4½" / $11 / 5 \mathrm{~cm}$ twice more- $(45,51,55)$ [61, 65, 71] \{75, 81, 87\} sts.
Work even until piece measures 17" / 43 cm from beginning, end on WS.
Shape Armholes: Bind off $(3,4,4)[5,5,6]\{6,7,7]$ sts at beginning of the next 2 rows- $(39,43,47)[51,55,59]\{63$, 67, 73\} sts.
Dec Row (RS): K1, k2tog, work to the last 3 sts, SSK, k1—2 sts dec'd.
Rep Dec Row every RS row $(2,3,4)[4,5,6]\{7,7,9]$ times more- $(33,35,37)[41,43,45]\{47,51,53\}$ sts.
Work even until armholes measure ( $71 / 2,8,81 / 2$ ) $[9,91 / 2,10]$ $\{1012,101 ⁄ 2,11\}^{\prime \prime} /(19,20.5,21.5)[23,24,25.5]\{26.5,26.5$, $28\} \mathrm{cm}$, end on WS.
Shape Shoulders: Bind off $(4,4,5)[6,6,7]\{7,8,9\}$ sts at beginning of the next 2 rows then $(3,4,4)[5,6,6]\{7,8,10\}$ sts at beginning of the next 2 rows.
Bind off remaining 19 sts for back neck.

## LEFT FRONT

With larger needles, cast on $(29,31,33)[35,39,41]\{43,47,51\}$ sts. Work even in Pattern Stitch for 8" / 20 cm , end on WS.
Dec Row (RS): K1, k2tog, work to end-1 st dec'd.
Rep Dec Row every $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} / 11.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ twice more- $(26,28,30)$ $[32,36,38]\{40,44,48\}$ sts. Work even until piece measures 17" / 42.5 cm from beginning, end on WS.
Shape Armhole: Bind off $(3,4,4)[5,5,6]\{6,7,7\}$ sts at beginning of the next RS row- $(23,24,26)[27,31,32]\{34$, $37,41\}$ sts.
Work 1 WS row.
Dec Row (RS): K1, k2tog, work to end-1 st dec'd.
Rep Dec Row every RS row 3 times more- $(19,20,22)$ [23, $27,28]\{30,33,37\}$ sts.



Work even until armhole measures $(41 / 2,5,51 / 2)[6,61 / 2,7]$ $\left\{7 \frac{1}{2}, 7 ½, 8\right\}^{\prime \prime} /(11.5,13,14)[15,16.5,18]\{19,19,20\} \mathrm{cm}$, end on RS.
Shape Neck: Next Row (WS): Work (6, 6, 7) [6, 9, 9$]\{10,11$, $12\}$ sts, slip these stitches to holder, then work to end-(13, $14,15)[17,18,19]\{20,22,25\}$ sts.
Dec 1 st at neck edge EVERY row 6 times- $(7,8,9)[11,12$, 13] $\{14,16,19\}$ sts.
Work even until armhole measures ( $71 / 2,8,81 / 2$ ) $[9,91 / 2,10]$
$\left\{10 \frac{1}{2}, 10^{1 ⁄ 2}, 11\right\}^{\prime \prime} /(19,20.5,21.5)[23,24,25.5]\{26.5,26.5,28\}$ cm , end on WS.
Shape Shoulder: Bind off $(4,4,5)[6,6,7]\{7,8,9\}$ sts at beginning of the next RS row, then $(3,4,4)[5,6,6]\{7,8,10\}$ sts at beginning of the last RS row. Fasten off.

## RIGHT FRONT

Work as for left front for 8" / 20 cm , end on WS—(29, 31, 33) $[35,39,41]\{43,47,51\}$ sts
Dec Row (RS): Work to last 3 sts, SSK, k1—1 st dec'd. Rep Dec Row every $4 ½$ " / 11.5 cm twice more- $(26,28,30)$ $[32,36,38]\{40,44,48\}$ sts. Work even until piece measures 17" / 43 cm from beginning, end on RS.
Shape Armhole: Next Row (WS): Bind off $(3,4,4)[5,5,6]\{6$, $7,7\}$ sts, work to end-( $23,24,26$ ) $[27,31,32]\{34,37,41\}$ sts. Dec Row (RS): Work to the last 3 sts, SSK, k1 - 1 st dec'd. Rep Dec Row every RS row 3 times more- $(19,20,22)$ [23, $27,28]\{30,33,37\}$ sts.

Work even until armhole measures $(41 / 2,5,51 / 2)[6,61 / 2,7]\{71 / 2$, $712,8\}^{\prime \prime} /(11.5,13,14)[15,16.5,18]\{19,19,20\} \mathrm{cm}$, end on WS.
Shape Neck: Next Row (RS): Work $(6,6,7)[6,9,9]\{10,11$, $12\}$ sts, slip these stitches to holder, then work to end - (13, $14,15)[17,18,19]\{20,22,25\}$ sts.
Dec 1 st at neck edge EVERY row 6 times- $(7,8,9)[11,12$, 13] $\{14,16,19\}$ sts.
Work even until armhole measures ( $71 / 2,8,81 / 2$ ) [9, 9½, 10] $\{101 / 2,101 / 2,11\}$ ", end on RS.
Shape Shoulder: Bind off $(4,4,5)[6,6,7]\{7,8,9\}$ sts at beginning of the next WS row, then $(3,4,4)[5,6,6]\{7,8,10\}$ sts at beginning of the last WS row. Fasten off.

## SLEEVES

With smaller needles, cast on 25 sts. Work even in Garter St for 4" / 10 cm . Change to larger needles and work even in Pattern Stitch until sleeve measures $41 / 22^{\prime \prime} / 11.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ from beginning, end on WS.
Inc Row (RS): K1, M1L, work to last stitch, M1R, k1-2 sts inc'd. Rep Inc Row every (22nd, 22nd, 14th) [10th, 8th, 6th] \{4th, 4th, 4th\} row $(2,2,3)[4,5,7]\{8,9,10\}$ times more- $(31,31$, 33) $[35,37,41]\{43,45,47\}$ sts.

Work even until sleeve measures 18" / 46 cm from beginning, end on WS.
Shape Cap: Bind off $(3,4,4)[5,5,6]\{6,7,7\}$ sts at beginning of the next 2 rows- $(25,23,25)[25,27,29]\{31,31,33\}$ sts.

Dec Row (RS): K1, k2tog, work to the last 3 sts, SSK, k1—2 sts dec'd.
Rep Dec Row every RS row $(4,1,2)[0,0,1]\{1,1,1\}$ time(s) more, then every 4 th row $(2,4,4)[5,5,5]\{5,5,5\}$ times, end on WS- $(11,11,11)[13,15,15]\{17,17,19\}$ sts. Bind off.

## FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams.

Collar: With RS facing, using smaller needles, begin at right front edge, join yarn and knit $(6,6,7)[6,9,9]\{10,11,12\}$ sts from right holder, pick up and knit 10 sts along right front neck edge, 19 sts across back neck edge, 10 sts along left front neck edge, then knit $(6,6,7)[6,9,9]\{10,11,12\}$ sts from left holder- $(51,51,53)[51,57,57]\{59,61,63\}$ sts. Work even in Garter St for 8 " / 20 cm , end on WS. Bind off knitwise. Weave in all ends and block as desired.
