FINISHED MEASUREMENTS Carousel/Aerial Version:

Approximately 10" / 25.5 cm tall, 30" / 76 cm around in motif section, 24" / 61 cm around at top, and 38" / 96.5 cm around at bottom

Carousel Version: Approximately 10¼" / 26 cm tall, 27" / 68.5 cm around in motif section, 23" / 58.5 cm around at top, and 36" / 91.5 cm around at bottom

YARN

For Carousel/Aerial Version: BERROCO CAROUSEL (100 grs): 2 balls #4420 Bottle Sand BERROCO AERIAL (25 grs): 2 balls #3441 Lagoon

For Carousel Verion: BERROCO CAROUSEL (100 grs): 2 balls #4438 Bingo

HOOKS and NOTIONS Crochet hook, size E / 3.5 mm or size to obtain gauge

GAUGE

One motif measures 41/2" / 11.5 cm square for Carousel Version, 5" / 12.5 cm square for Carousel/Aerial Version 21 dc and 12 rows = 4'' / 10 cm for Carousel Version, 20 dc and 11 rows = 4" / 10 cm for Carousel/Aerial Version Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

CONSTRUCTION NOTES

Cowl is made starting with a ring of joined motifs. After motifs are complete, additional rows are worked at the top and bottom of the cowl.

Note: For Carousel/Aerial version, both yarns are held together throughout.



SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

Htr—Half Treble: Yo twice, insert hook into st, yo and draw up a loop (4 loops on hook). Yo, draw hook through 2 loops (3 loops on hook). Yo, draw hook through all 3 loops.

FIRST MOTIF

Begin with a sliding loop, or ch 4 and join the last ch to the first with a sl st to make a loop.

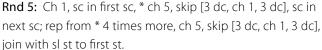
Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc throughout), dc in loop, * ch 4, 3 dc in loop; rep from * 4 times more, ch 4, dc in loop, join with sl st to 3rd ch of beg ch 3.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in same st, * skip 1 st, [sc, hdc, dc, ch 1, dc, hdc, sc] in ch-4 sp, skip 1 st, sc in next st; rep from * 4 times more, skip 1 st, [sc, hdc, dc, ch 1, dc, hdc, sc] in ch-4 sp, skip 1 st, join with sl st to first st.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in same sc, * ch 4, skip [3 sts, ch-1 sp, and 3 sts], sc in next sc; rep from * 4 times more, ch 1, dc into first sc to join (creates last ch-4 sp). Note: Move "petals" in front of ch-4 sps after completing the row.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc over joining dc, * [3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc] in next sc, sc in ch-4 sp; rep from * 4 times more, [3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc] in next sc, join with sl st to first st. Place a marker in the first ch-1 sp of this round for reference when working Rnd 7.





Rnd 6: Ch 3, 3 dc in same sc, * sc in ch-5 sp, [4 dc, ch 1, 4 dc] in next sc; rep from * 4 times more, sc in ch-5 sp, 4 dc in same st as first sts, join with sc to 3rd ch of beg ch 3 (creates last ch-1 sp).

Rnd 7: Ch 1, sc over joining sc, * ch 4, tr in ch-1 sp of Rnd 4 below, ch 4, sc in ch-1 sp of Rnd 6; rep from * 4 times more, ch 4, tr in ch-1 sp of Rnd 4 below, ch 4, join with sl st to first st.

Rnd 8: Ch 1, sc in first sc, * 4 sc in ch-4 sp, sc in next st; rep from * 10 times more, 4 sc in ch-4 sp, join with sl st to first st.

Rnd 9: Ch 5 (counts as tr + ch 1), * htr in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st, dc in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st, hdc in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st, sc in next 2 sts, ch 1, skip 1 st, hdc in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st, dc in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st, htr in next st, ch 1, [tr, ch 3, tr] in next st, ch 1; rep from * twice more, htr in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st, dc in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st, hdc in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st, sc in next 2 sts, ch 1, skip 1 st, hdc in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st, dc in next st, ch 1, in same st as first st, ch 1, join with hdc to 4th ch of beg ch 4 (creates last ch-3 sp).



Rnd 10: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc over joining hdc, * [dc in next st, dc in ch-1 sp] 4 times, dc in next 2 sts, [dc in ch-1 sp, dc in next st] 4 times, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in ch-3 sp; rep from * twice more, [dc in next st, dc in ch-1 sp] 4 times, dc in next 2 sts, [dc in ch-1 sp, dc in next st] 4 times, 2 dc in same sp as first sts, ch 1, join with sc to 3rd ch of beg ch 3 (creates last ch-2 sp).

Fasten off.

MOTIFS 2-6

Work Rnds 1–10 as for first motif, but do not fasten off. Join to last motif made to form a strip as follows: Hold squares WS together, work sc into corner spaces on both squares at the same time. Work sc into both loops of each st of both squares across one side, then work sc in the next corner spaces on both squares. Fasten off.

At the end of Motif 6, after joining one side to Motif 5, join the opposite side in the same way to the first motif to form cowl, and do not fasten off.

TOP SECTION

Rnd 1: With yarn attached from last join, ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), * skip corner space, [dc in next dc, ch 1, skip 1 dc] 5 times, dc2tog, [ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next dc] 5 times,



ch 1, skip corner space, dc in joining st between motifs; rep from from * across the next 4 motifs, then rep from * once more over last motif, omitting last dc, join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch 4—72 dc and 72 ch-1 sp.

Rnd 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), * dc in ch-1 sp, dc in next dc; rep from * to last st, dc in last ch-1 sp, join with sl st to 3rd ch of beg ch 3—144 dc.

Rnd 3—Dec Rnd: Ch 3 (counts as dc), * skip next dc, [dc in next dc, ch 1, skip 1 dc] 10 times, dc in next dc, skip next dc, dc in next dc; rep from from * 4 times more, then rep from * once more, omitting last dc, join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch 4—72 dc and 60 ch-1 sp.

Rnd 4: Ch 3 (counts as dc), * dc in next dc, [dc in ch-1 sp, dc in next dc] 10 times, dc in next dc; rep from * 4 times more, then rep from * once more, omitting last dc, join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch 4—132 dc.

Rnd 5—Dec Rnd: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), skip next 2 dc, [dc in next dc, ch 1, skip next dc] 8 times, dc in next dc, ch 1, skip next 2 dc, * dc in next dc, ch 1, skip next 2 dc, [dc in next dc, ch 1, skip next dc] 8 times, dc in next dc, ch 1, skip next 2 dc; rep from from * 4 times more, join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch 4—60 dc and 60 ch-1 sp.

Rnd 6: Ch 3 (counts as dc), * dc in ch-1 sp, dc in next dc; rep from * to last st, dc in last ch-1 sp, join with sl st to 3rd ch of beg ch 3—120 dc.

For Carousel/Aerial Version ONLY: Fasten off.

For Carousel Version ONLY: Rnd 7: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), skip next dc, * dc in next dc, ch 1, skip next dc; rep from * to end, join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch 4.

Rnd 8: Rep Rnd 6. Fasten off.

BOTTOM SECTION

(Both versions worked the same).

Rnd 1: Join yarn in the joining st between first and last motifs, ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), * dc in corner space, ch 1, [dc in next dc, ch 1, skip 1 dc] 5 times, dc2tog, [ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next dc] 5 times, ch 1, dc in corner space, ch 1, dc in joining st between motifs, ch 1; rep from from * across the next 4 motifs, then rep from * once more over last motif, omitting last dc, join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch 4—84 dc and 84 ch-1 sp.

Rnd 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), * dc in ch-1 sp, dc in next dc; rep from * to last st, dc in last ch-1 sp, join with sl st to 3rd ch of beg ch 3—168 dc.

Rnd 3—Inc Rnd: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), dc in same st, [ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next dc] 13 times, ch 1, skip next dc, * [dc, ch 1, dc] in next st, [ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next dc] 13 times, ch 1, skip next dc; rep from from * 4 times more join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch 4—90 dc and 90 ch-1 sp.

Rnd 4: SI st in ch-1 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), * dc in next dc, dc in ch-1 sp; rep from * to last st, dc in last dc, join with sI st to 3rd ch of beg ch 3—180 dc.

Rnd 5—Inc Rnd: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in same st, [ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next dc] 14 times, ch 1, skip next dc, * 3 dc in next st, [ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next dc] 14 times, ch 1, skip next dc; rep from from * 4 times more, dc in same sp as beg ch 3 and dc, join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch 3—102 dc and 90 ch-1 sp.

Rnd 6: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next dc, [dc in ch-1 sp, dc in next dc] 14 times, dc in ch-1 sp, * dc in next 3 dc, [dc in ch-1 sp, dc in next dc] 14 times, dc in ch-1 sp; rep from * to last st, dc in ch-1 sp, dc in last dc, join with sl st to 3rd ch of beg ch 3—192 dc.

Rnd 7: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), skip next dc, * dc in next dc, ch 1, skip next dc; rep from * to end, join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch 4—96 dc and 96 ch-1 sp.

Rnd 8: Rep Rnd 2. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

dtr: double treble crochet

est: established FLO: front loop only est: established FP: front post

FPdc: front post double crochet **FPhdc:** front post half double crochet

FPsc: front post single crochet **FPtc:** front post treble crochet **hdc:** half double crochet

hdc2tog: half double crochet 2 stitches together

inc: increase
MC: main color
pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker
rep: repeat
rnd(s): round(s)

RS: right side sc: single crochet

sc2tog: single crochet 2 stitches together

sl st: slip stitch

sliding loop: Form a loop of yarn around your fingers, with the end attached to the ball on the right and the tail on the left. Insert hook into the loop under both pieces of yarn and draw up a loop onto hook. (This does not count as your first stitch.) Work first row into the original loop. Pull up the yarn tail after your first row is complete to close the loop.

tog: together
tr: treble

WS: wrong sideyo: yarn over
