#### HOOKS and NOTIONS

Crochet hook, size 4 mm / G or size to obtain gauge Five %" buttons


## GAUGE

18 sts and 25 rows = 4'' / 10 cm in pattern stitch To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.

#### NOTE

Garment is worked in one piece from left sleeve cuff to right sleeve cuff.

#### PATTERN STITCH

Any number of stitches + ch 1

**Set-Up Row (WS):** Sc in second ch from hook and in each ch to end, turn.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, \* sc-tbl in each sc to end, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, \* sc-tfl in each sc to end, turn.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 for Pattern Stitch.

# LEFT SLEEVE

Ch (23, 23, 29) [29, 33, 33]. Work even in Pattern Stitch for 8 rows—(22, 22, 28, 28, 32, 32) sc.

Inc Row (RS): Work 2 sc in first sc, work to last sc, work 2 sc in last sc—2 sc inc'd.

Rep Inc Row every RS row (6, 8, 6) [8, 7, 8] times more— (36, 40, 42) [46, 48, 50] sts.

Work even until sleeve measures  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " / 16.5 cm, end on WS. Make a note of how many rows you worked after the last Inc Row.

Body: Next Row (RS): Ch (25, 25, 29) [29, 31, 31].

Work Set-Up Row of Pattern Stitch across these chains, then work across remaining (36, 40, 42) [46, 48, 50] sts in pattern as established, turn—(60, 64, 70) [74, 78, 80] sts.

Next Row (WS): Ch (25, 25, 29) [29, 31, 31]. Work Set-Up Row of Pattern Stitch across these chains, then work across remaining sts, turn—(84, 88, 98) [102, 108, 110] sts.

Work even in pattern as established until piece measures (2½, 3, 3) [3¼, 3¼, 3¾]" / (6.5, 7.5, 7.5) [8.5, 8.5, 9.5] cm from beginning of Body, end on WS.

Shape Back Neck: Next Row (RS): Work (42, 44, 49) [51, 54, 55] sts in pattern as established, turn. Work even on these sts until back neck measures (4½, 4½, 5) [5, 5½, 5½]" / (11.5, 11.5, 12.5) [12.5, 14, 14] cm, end on RS. Break off yarn.







# **LEFT FRONT**

**Shape Neck:** With RS facing, rejoin yarn to front at point where back neck started.

Next Row (RS): SI st across the first 4 sts, then work in pattern as established to end—4 sts dec'd. Work 1 row even. SI st across the first 3 sts of the next RS row, then 1 st at beginning of the next RS row—(34, 36, 41) [43, 46, 47] sts. Work even in pattern as established until front measures (4¾, 5¼, 5½) [5¾, 6, 6½]" / (12, 13.5, 14) [14.5, 15, 15.5] cm from beginning of body, end on WS. Mark placement of 5 buttonholes along last row, the first 2 sc from neck edge, the last 2 sc from lower edge, and the other 3 evenly space between.

**Buttonhole Row (RS):** Work even in pattern as established, working ch 2, skip 2 sc at each marker for buttonholes. Work even for 1 more row, working 2 sc in each ch 2 sp across. Fasten off.

## RIGHT FRONT

Ch (35, 37, 42) [44, 47, 48]. Beginning with Set-Up Row, work even in Pattern Stitch until piece measures (1¾, 1¾, 2) [2, 2¼, 2¼]" / (4.5, 4.5, 5) [5, 5.5, 5.5] cm, end on WS—(34, 36, 41) [43, 46, 47] sts..

**Shape Neck: Next Row (RS):** Ch 2, sc in second ch from hook, then work in Pattern Stitch to end—1 st inc'd. Work 1 row even.

Next Row (RS): Ch 4, sc in second ch from hook and in remaining 2 ch, then work in Pattern Stitch to end—3 sts inc'd. Work 1 row even.

Next Row (RS): Ch 5, sc in second ch from hook and in remaining 3 ch, then work in Pattern Stitch to end—(42, 44, 49) [51, 54, 55] sts.

**Joining Row (WS):** Work across (42, 44, 49) [51, 54, 55] sts of Right Front, then work across (42, 44, 49) [51, 54, 55] sts of Back—(84, 88, 98) [102, 108, 110] sts.

Work even until piece measures (9½, 10½, 11) [11½, 12, 13]" / (24, 26.5, 28) [29, 30.5, 33] cm from beginning of body, end on WS.

#### RIGHT SLEEVE

**Next Row (RS):** SI st across the first (24, 24, 28) [28, 30, 30] sts, then work in pattern as established across the next (36, 40, 42) [46, 48, 50] sts, turn, leaving the remaining stitches unworked—(36, 40, 42) [46, 48, 50] sts.

Work even until the same number of rows have been worked as you worked from the last Inc Row on Left Sleeve to beginning of Body, end on WS.

**Dec Row (RS):** Dec 1 st at beginning and end of row—2 sts dec'd


Rep Dec Row every other row (6, 8, 6) [8, 7, 8] times more—(22, 22, 28) [28, 32, 32] sts. Work even until sleeve measures 6½" / 16.5 cm from end of Body, end on WS. Fasten off.

# **FINISHING**

**Collar:** With WS facing, beginning  $\frac{1}{4}$ " / .5 cm in from left front edge, work (51, 56, 62) [65, 71, 77] sc along left front neck edge, back neck edge, then right front neck edge to  $\frac{1}{4}$ " / .5 cm from right front edge. Work even in Pattern Stitch for 3" / 7.5 cm. Fasten off.

Sew buttons to Right Front, opposite buttonholes. Weave in all ends and block as desired.

- **D** (Sleeve Length): 61/2" / 16.5 cm
- **E** (Back Width): (9½, 10½, 11) [11½, 12, 13]" / (24, 26.5, 28) [29, 30.5, 33] cm
- **F** (Front Width): (5, 5½, 5¾) [6, 6¼, 6¾]" / (12.5, 14, 14.5) [15, 16, 17] cm
- **G** (Back Neck Width): (4½, 4½, 5) [5, 5½, 5½]" / (11.5, 11.5, 12.5) [12.4, 14, 14] cm

sliding loop: Form a loop of yarn around your fingers, with the end attached to the ball on the right and the tail on the left. Insert hook into the loop under both pieces of yarn and draw up a loop onto hook. (This does not count as your first stitch.) Work first row into the original loop. Pull up the yarn tail after your first row is complete to close the loop.

sp: space st(s): stitch(es)

tbl: through back loop tfl: through front loop

tog: together tr: treble

**WS:** wrong side yo: yarn over
